WHEREAS, Dedicated to the community in which he lives, Anthony Rossello has volunteered his time and energy to both the Little League and Babe Ruth baseball programs and has served as a Fireman; in addition, he is a vital member of the Melvin Roads American Legion; and

WHEREAS, In his much deserved retirement, Anthony Rossello enjoys spending time with his beloved family and loves to spend time on the water fishing; and

WHEREAS, With him throughout have been his wife of 60 years, the former Joan Russell; his four children, Anthony, Jr., Lynn, Paul and Joanne; and his eight grandchildren, as well as one great-grandchild, all of whom feel privileged to be a part of his life and rejoice in his accomplishments; and
