

Senator Larkin Secures \$135,000 For Town Of Cornwall Highway Department

The Cornwall Highway Department maintains over 42 miles of roadway and 6.6 miles of sidewalk in the Town, as well as winter maintenance on 12.5 miles of County roads. The Highway Superintendent is also responsible for the Town's Sanitation Department.
