Senator Elaine Phillips (R-Manhasset) and the New York Legal Assistance Group (NYLAG) will be holding a free program in Mineola to provide free legal services to those in need.

The Mobile Legal Help Center will be at the Mineola Memorial Library (195 Marcellus Road, Mineola) on Tuesday, February 7th from 10 am to 3 pm. The Mobile Legal Help Center, which is a partnership between the New York Legal Assistance Group (NYLAG) and the New York State Office of Court Administration, brings free, civil legal services directly into communities.

NYLAG staff will be available to provide free legal assistance to local residents on issues related to:

- Domestic violence
- Family Law
- Healthcare and disability benefits
- Housing (tenants only)
- Identity theft and consumer credit issues
- Advance Planning

Individuals should bring with them any documentation related to their situation that may be useful to the NYLAG staff in providing assistance. Appointments are highly recommended but walk-ins will be accepted and served if time permits.
