

Senator Bonacic Announces \$75,000 Grant for the Village of Goshen

Hope) is pleased to announce that the Village of Goshen will receive a \$75,000 grant for the construction of new sidewalks on Greenwich Avenue in the Village. The grant was secured through the State Municipal Facilities Program, funding for which was secured in the 2016-2017 State Budget.
