WHEREAS, After earning an assistant position at Niagara University in 2002, Matt Dillon was instrumental in the school reaching the NCAA tournament in 2005; and

WHEREAS, Athletes such as Matt Dillon provide a tremendous service to the future of our State and Nation, inspiring generations of student-athletes in their athletic journeys and ensuring their success in their future years; and

WHEREAS, This Legislative Body is moved to honor Matt Dillon for his extraordinary athletic accomplishments which are a tribute to his skill, dedication and commitment; now, therefore, be it
