LIVONIA – Running the race of her life, Livonia High School junior Hayleigh Palotti won a come-from-behind victory to capture the 2016 NYSPHSAA Class C Cross Country Championship. In recognition of this crowning achievement, Senator Catharine Young (R,C,I-57th District) presented her with a New York State Senate Resolution.

"Hayleigh is a remarkable young woman, and this season was a testament to her dedication and perseverance. Coming off a brilliant first season last year, Hayleigh knew had the potential to put together an impressive season. Hayleigh Palotti dominated the Section V Class C season, winning races at the McQuaid Invitational, the Wayne Invitational, and the McDaniel-Baxter Championships. She won the Section V Class C Championship, pulling away in the second mile of the double-loop course at Victor High School and finishing with the day's fastest time among the female competitors. Following up on her Sectional win, Palotti used her exceptional speed to produce a come-from-behind attack to win the Class C state title.
