COMMEMORATING the 125th Anniversary of the FASNY
Firemen's Home

WHEREAS, Attendant to such concern, and in full accord with its long-standing traditions, this Legislative Body is justly proud to commemorate the 125th Anniversary of the FASNY Firemen's Home; and

WHEREAS, The FASNY Firemen's Home is a non-profit organization which provides cost free quality nursing care to volunteer firefighters who have served in New York State for one year or more in their lifetime; and

WHEREAS, This momentous occasion will be recognized with a two day celebration, kicking off on Friday, May 19, 2017, with a Memorial Service at FASNY Firemen's Home in Hudson, New York; a special dedication will follow the ceremony to unveil the new seven-foot stained glass Caring Window which symbolizes the dignity and pride in volunteer service; and

WHEREAS, The success of the FASNY Firemen's Home is in direct correlation to the efforts of its staff, whose involvement is, and always has been, characterized by an impressive commitment, an unbridled enthusiasm, and an uncompromising standard of excellence in all endeavors on behalf of the organization and the community it serves; and

WHEREAS, It is the custom of this Legislative Body that when organizations of such noble aims and accomplishments are brought to our attention, they should be recognized and applauded by all the citizens of this great Empire State; now, therefore, be it
