WHEREAS, Brian G. Xuereb was commissioned into the New York State Chaplain Task Force in December of 2016, and hopes to work as a Chaplain for the NYPD in the coming months; he has been a substance abuse counselor for four years, and currently serves as an instructor in the field; and

WHEREAS, With a passion for woodworking, Brian G. Xuereb builds furniture and toys for his family and friends, including his 11 nieces and nephews; and

WHEREAS, Brian G. Xuereb is an active member of the Ancient Order of Hibernians, where he continues to preserve his Irish heritage, culture and Catholic faith; and

WHEREAS, A St. Patrick's Day Parade reflects and records the ongoing history of the United States and Ireland, and provides an opportunity for people of all generations to assemble in ethnic pride and pageantry; and

WHEREAS, A fitting choice for Deputy Marshal for the Bay Ridge St. Patrick's Day Parade, Brian G. Xuereb embodies the spirit and the cherished ideals and values of Irish-Americans of this great State and Nation; and
