WHEREAS, Jeff Anastasia's accomplishments are truly outstanding; he has been the recipient of many coaching awards including: the Bob Johnson Memorial Cattaraugus County Boys Coach of the Year Award, the Thomas K. Oakley Big 30 Coach of the Year Award, the BCANY Section VI Coach of the Year, the BCANY-New Balance N.Y.S. Boys Coach of the Year, the BCANY Coach of the Year Class B, The BCANY CCAA League Coach of the Year, the BCANY Service Award for 25 years of coaching, the Centercourt Coach of the Year and the Section VI Coaches Sportsmanship Award; he has also received BCANY Recognition Awards for 100, 200, 300, 400, and 500 victories in addition to being inducted into the Olean High School Wall of Fame, the Cattaraugus Hall of Fame, and the New York State Basketball Hall of Fame; and
