WHEREAS, As a child, Nijaah Howard enjoyed helping her mother in the kitchen, and grew to love cooking; after high school, she enrolled in The New York Restaurant School where she graduated with a degree in the culinary arts; shortly thereafter, she went to work at the Windows on the World restaurant in New York City; and

WHEREAS, After 9/11, Nijaah Howard reevaluated her life, and founded Millennium Minds, Inc., a non-profit mentoring program designed to give inner city youth the gift of exposing them to life outside of their communities; she returned to college, and earned her bachelor's degree in both psychology and sociology from CUNY Queens College; after graduation, she worked with youth who struggled with mental health or developmental disabilities; and

WHEREAS, After obtaining her master's degree in mental health, Nijaah Howard became the Chief Executive Officer of Young Men Strong, LLC, a media, consulting and mentoring company structured to educate, empower, and unite men of all color, providing preventive training programs to reduce recidivism; and

WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body that those who enhance the well-being and vitality of their community and have shown a long and sustained commitment to excellence certainly have earned the recognition and applause of all the citizens of this great Empire State; now, therefore, be it
