WHEREAS, With a steadfast and unwavering dedication to the law enforcement community, Michael Essig served as Chairman of Homeland Security for the 19th Congressional District, as well as Parliamentarian and Vice-President of the Orange County Shields, and Vice-President of the Rockland County Steuben Association; he is also a member of the Rockland County Shields; and

WHEREAS, Michael Essig proudly serves as a member on the Board of Directors for the Hudson Valley Easter Seals Thanksgiving and Christmas food pantry outreach programs; and
