COMMENDING the Norwegian-American 17th of May
Committee of Greater New York upon the occasion of

WHEREAS, Attendant to such concern, and in full accord with its
long-standing traditions, this Legislative Body is justly proud to
commend the Norwegian-American 17th of May Committee of Greater New York
upon the occasion of hosting its 65th Annual Norwegian Constitution Day
Parade to be celebrated on Sunday, May 21, 2017, in Bay Ridge, Brooklyn,
New York, in conjunction with the commemoration of the 203rd Anniversary
of the signing of Norway's Constitution; and

Day Parade which marches down Fifth Avenue, and in accordance with their
