WHEREAS, The success of the Lakeville Branch Library is in direct correlation to the efforts of Ruth Klement, whose involvement was characterized by an impressive commitment, an unbridled enthusiasm, and an uncompromising standard of excellence in all endeavors on behalf of the library and the community it serves; and
