A member of the Senate Select Committee on Libraries since 2012, Senator Ritchie was named Chair of the committee in January. The newly enacted state budget contains more than \$95 million in overall funding for public libraries across the state, which includes \$4 million more than the Governor proposed. The budget also contains \$24 million for important library capital projects and upgrades. Since 2011, Senator Ritchie has secured nearly \$350,000 in special funding to bolster libraries across Central and Northern New York.
