This year, New York State has set aside \$478 million for local roads, PLUS an extra \$65 million for Extreme Winter Recovery a total of \$543 million.



This year's budget has the largest commitment ever by New York State to clean water: \$2.5 billion for water projects around the state, including local sewers and waterways.



\$500 million will go towards redeveloping the DL&W Terminal, revitalizing the East Side, expanding Metro Rail, and much more.



### RIDESHARING

As of July, Buffalo will no longer be the largest city in the United States without ridesharing. This year's budget finally brings services like Lyft and Uber to Upstate New York.



## #BFair2DirectCare

Direct care workers will receive a hard-earned raise, ensuring that the 128,000 New Yorkers with developmental disabilities receive the care they need, and that direct care workers receive the compensation they deserve.
