WHEREAS, Due to her vibrant personality and astute management skills, Marcie Lahr has numerous volunteers that have been with the organization for years, including several that have reached 20 or more years of volunteer service; and

WHEREAS, Under Marcie Lahr's luminous leadership, the Lovejoy site has served more than 1,000 clients since 1987; and

WHEREAS, Throughout the entire period of her community service, a period of constructive involvement, Marcie Lahr has stood constant in dignity, good grace and humor; and

WHEREAS, Rare indeed is the impressive dedication shown by an individual for the benefit of others which Marcie Lahr has displayed throughout her life; and

WHEREAS, It is the custom of this Legislative Body that those who enhance the well-being and vitality of their community and have shown a long and sustained commitment to excellence certainly have earned the recognition and applause of all the citizens of this great Empire State; now, therefore, be it
