Donations of non-perishable food, bottled water, diapers, baby food, batteries, tampons and pads, and first aid supplies, can be accepted at the Senator's district office. All items must be unused and in their original, unopened packaging. The office also set-up a virtual store where people can go online to purchase which will automatically be sent to Long Island Cares and then to Puerto Rico through the online store here.

Donations will be accepted through October, and can be dropped off at Senator Kaminsky's district office, located at 55 Front Street in Rockville Centre.
