Prevention is key to avoiding cavities and dental pain, and we're delighted to bring this service to the community. I encourage Rochester residents to bring their entire family to this free health screening." EIOH's SMILEmobile program—a dental office on wheels—will be available on **Thursday, October 26th** from **3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.** at the parking lot at **St. Monica Church**, 831 Genesee

Street.

"Screenings take only 15 minutes," said Carletta Carter, RDA, EIOH's community liaison.

"We'll let residents know if they have any dental concerns and make recommendations.

Maintaining good oral health by brushing and flossing is important to the whole body, and takes only a few minutes each day."
