BROOKLYN, NY (10/23/17) – Over the course of three days and at different locations throughout the 21st Senate District, Senator Kevin Parker, in conjunction with Citi Health Home Care Services, Duanereade by Walgreens, New York-Presbyterian Brooklyn Methodist Hospital, and Lenox Road Baptist Church hosted the legislator's Annual Flu Shot event.
