"I am honored to recognize these special people who have gone above and beyond the call of duty to serve our nation, as well as make major contributions to the communities where they live and work. Our region is home to some of the most amazing heroes, and I hope people will take a moment to nominate them for their selfless service."

Last year, Senator Ritchie honored 27 local veterans from all branches of the U.S. Armed Services through the Veterans Hall of Fame initiative. Information on this year's event will be released at a later date.

In recent years, dozens of individuals have been recognized by Senator Ritchie for fighting in some of history's most dangerous battles, including, World War II's Invasion of Normandy, Iwo Jima and the Battle of the Bulge, as well as more recent conflicts in Vietnam, Iraq and Afghanistan.
