Senator Ritchie presented each student with a certificate and thanked them, and their teachers, for their hard work in helping such an important cause.

I wanted to make sure they know their hard work, the hard work of all of their teachers and the support of their family and community is something all of New York State is exceptionally proud of,” Senator Ritchie said.
