Children's Hospital provides free blankets to kids undergoing treatment, but because of the number of pediatric patients that visit the hospital each year, it must rely on community donations.

The community is invited to drop off newly purchased blankets at Senator Gallivan's District Office at 2721 Transit Road, Suite 116 during regular business hours, Monday – Friday. Donations will be accepted through January 31, 2019.

Again, this year, many schools within Senator Gallivan's district have agreed to help collect blankets.

Last year's Senator Gallivan's office collected over 1,000 blankets for pediatric patients.
