During the 2018 Legislative Session, I was pleased to co-sponsor the **Toll Payer Protection Act**, which mitigates some of the problems vehicle owners have faced due to the expansion of cashless tolling throughout the state. [S.8946/A.9805-A](#) was delivered to the Governor for his signature on Monday, December 17th, and he has until Friday, December 28th to sign or veto the bill.
