WATERLOO – Senator Pam Helming recently visited Waterloo High School to recognize student-athletes from the girls varsity cross country team that won the section championship during the fall season as well as two student-athletes who won individual section championships during the winter season. She presented a New York State Senate Proclamation to the girls cross country team that won the Section V, Class C championship. She also presented Proclamations to runner Riley Corey, who won the Section V, Class C 3000m Indoor Track and Field championship, and to wrestler Jake DeWall, who won the Section V, Class BBB 285-pound Wrestling championship. Senator Helming also gave New

York State Senate Citations to Cross Country Coach Ed Courtney for being named Finger Lakes Eastern Division Coach of the Year, Section V Class C Coach of the Year, and All-Greater Rochester Coach of the Year and to Wrestling Coach Tyrone Thomas for being named Finger Lakes Central Coach of the Year.
