WHEREAS, With a sense of civic responsibility, this remarkable man made public service a lifetime commitment; Police Chief Dominick Hiffa was a lifetime active member of the New York State Chiefs Association; a lifetime active member of the New York Mills Fire Department, joining the day he turned 18; and was named Officer of the Year in 2014; and
