Hempstead Housing Authority, and Long Island Housing Services, Inc. were present to provide attendees with additional information and service referrals.

"Every person deserves access to affordable, secure housing," said Senator Thomas. "The Housing Fair was a great opportunity to discuss how New York's new laws can help residents, and hear their concerns and questions about housing in their own communities."
