

Ritchie Attends Hearing to Discuss Rural Broadband Access in New York State

State Senator Patty Ritchie took part in a special joint New York State Senate and Assembly public hearing in Albany Tuesday. The hearing was to discuss ways the legislature can make high-speed internet more available to rural areas of the state—including the North Country.

Senator Ritchie, who is a member of the Senate's Rural Resources Commission, heard testimony from stakeholders from across the state on how expanded broadband can help
