
Senate Passes Gianaris' Automatic Voter Registration Bill, Strengthening And Expanding New Yorkers' Voting Rights

Senator Gianaris' bill, <u>S.6457B</u>, creates a system of automatic voter registration within designated agency applications at the Departments of Health and Motor Vehicles.
