Yonkers, NY- Senate Majority Leader and local State Senator, Andrea Stewart-Cousins, has taken swift action to help ensure New York State is better prepared to address the spread of COVID-19, more commonly referred to as "coronavirus." Under her leadership, the Senate passed legislation which included \$40 million to help the State address the coronavirus.
