

Skoufis Launches Restaurant Hand Sanitizer Initiative on 5/19

On Tuesday, May 19, 50 local restaurants that responded to Skoufis' social media outreach will distribute sanitizers to the first 50 customers to place an order. The foodservice industry is a major employer in the Hudson Valley as many restaurants continue to face hardship and struggle to make ends meet during the pandemic. Skoufis' initiative attempts to provide a boost to business on May 19 by incentivizing customers to place an order while simultaneously distributing hand sanitizer into our communities

"Our goal with this initiative is to support local small businesses while promoting sound public health.
