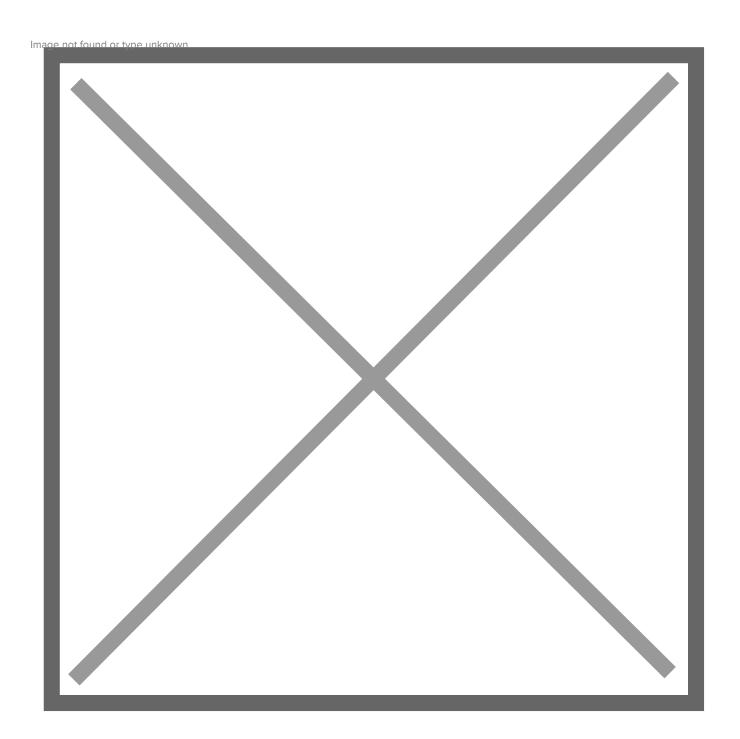


State Senator Kevin Provides School Supplies and PPE For Brooklyn Students
