Senator Weik, the former Receiver of Taxes for the Town of Islip, was elected Nov. 3 to represent the 3rd Senate District, comprising parts of the Towns of Brookhaven and Islip.

While today's event marks the official start of my term as Senator, I've already been hard at work learning about issues that face our district and the entire state.
