WHEREAS, From December of 1943 to September of 1944, Terry R. Larkin

participated in 10 major landings, and facilitated and enhanced tactical and strategic air power for the air forces and supported ground combat units in driving the Japanese out of their respective areas; and

WHEREAS, For his meritorious service, Terry R. Larkin was awarded the Asiatic Pacific Service Medal with BR Arrowhead, Good Conduct Medal, Philippines Liberation Ribbon with 2 Bronze Stars, Purple Heart and World War II Victory Medal; and

WHEREAS, Terry R. Larkin, with his zest for life, has inspired and enhanced the lives of his family and friends; and

WHEREAS, This exceptional centenarian has experienced the incredible joys and sorrows characteristic of and reserved for those with the stamina and courage to savor a full life; and

WHEREAS, Terry R. Larkin has enriched the lives of those around him through his joyous and sincere love for others and through the quiescent charm and wisdom which comes only from a fullness of years; and
