WHEREAS, Warren Leib, with his commitment and investment, was able to advocate for more technology and library programs, work collaboratively with library leadership, and continue his efforts of education and improving literacy within the community; and

WHEREAS, The future success of our State and Nation is dependent upon individuals such as Warren Leib, who have dedicated their lives as educators, nurturing our most precious resource, our youth; and

WHEREAS, As a knowledgeable and highly skilled teacher, coach, principal, superintendent, and member of the board of directors, this extraordinary man has improved the quality of education at Pulaski School and Library by leading and supporting staff with enthusiasm, cultivating a positive and stimulating school environment for his
