WHEREAS, A vital member of the MJC community, Barbara Stein has served in many capacities over the years, including as President from 2017-2019, during which time she was instrumental in the increase in Shabbat attendance and in the positivity, which was felt by all during the Egalitarian Conservative services; and

WHEREAS, Furthermore, under the able leadership of Barbara Stein, there was a greater awareness of Madison within the Brooklyn community

due to new programming, signage and advertisements of events in the new outdoor showcases; and

WHEREAS, Additionally, Barbara Stein has been a past PA President and has acted as the Annual Fashion Show Coordinator for more than a decade; and
