WHEREAS, Additionally, the NIA serves thousands of senior citizens through its senior picnics, senior proms, health and nutrition initiatives, and support programs; and

WHEREAS, During the COVID-19 pandemic, NIA Community Services Network assisted countless community members in need through free assistance with healthcare, SNAP, senior support, unemployment, Meals on Wheels, price gouging, Home Health Aides, and personal health, as well as after school programs to help supplement for lost hours of learning and provide social-emotional support to students; and

WHEREAS, The success of NIA Community Services Network is in direct correlation to the efforts of its dedicated staff and volunteers, whose involvement is, and always has been, characterized by an impressive commitment, an unbridled enthusiasm, and an uncompromising standard of

excellence in all endeavors on behalf of the organization and the community it serves; and
