WHEREAS, The Queens Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. fosters sisterhood among its local membership, while providing extraordinary work in enhancing and providing community service, scholarships and empowerment to communities and residents throughout Queens; and

WHEREAS, Working with community leaders, educators, and social activists to impact lives and transform their global and diverse community, this vital organization has awarded countless scholarships to deserving students; and
