WHEREAS, After attending Concordia Teachers College for one year, Jim Harris, Sr. returned to Albany to start a career; with experience he learned from delivering the Times Union and the Knickerbocker newspapers to his 200 customers at the age of 12, he set out to look for a job; and

WHEREAS, During this time, he found work delivering liquor to bars and liquor stores between Albany and south to Palisades, while also attending night school at Russell Sage; and

WHEREAS, Today, Jim Harris, Sr. is the Founder and Chairman of Janitronics Facility Services, which was launched in March of 1972, and under his able leadership, has grown in excess of 1,800 employees and performs high performance cleaning for schools, office complexes, semi-conductor facilities and health related critical care units; and

WHEREAS, This extraordinary man is also past President of the Building Service Contractors Association International, co-founder of

The Maids International, and Founder and CEO of Concepts4 International Consulting; and

WHEREAS, Co-founder and Chairman Emeritus of the Cleaning Industry Research Institute International, Jim Harris, Sr. also oversaw the research for the ISSA K-12 Cleaning Standard; and

WHEREAS, With a steadfast and unwavering commitment to his community, Jim Harris, Sr. has served as President of both Shenendehowa Junior Plainsmen youth football and the Albany County Cancer Society, as well as a Board member of Capitol District Youth for Christ and a 10-year Board member of St. Ann's Institute; he is also past President of the Capitol Region Chamber; and

WHEREAS, Furthermore, he served on the Boards of St. Peters Foundation and Search Ministries, Inc., and is a member of Our Saviors Lutheran Church and the Albany Country Club; and

WHEREAS, In addition to his son, the late Jeff, with him throughout have been Jim Jr., Jill and Lan Jin, all of whom feel privileged to be a part of his life and rejoice in his many achievements; and
