WHEREAS, During his tenure as Deputy Chief, Kevin Simons was instrumental in getting the Rome Police Department accredited by New York State; additionally, he played a vital role in the proposal and creation of the Office of Professional Standards, which was established to serve as a review committee for complaints against the department; and

WHEREAS, A true asset to his community, Kevin Simons has coached Rome sports for 30 years, officiated local sports for 34 years and is the voice of Rome Free Academy hockey games; and

WHEREAS, In his capacity as Deputy Police Chief, Kevin Simons served with loyalty, honor and distinction, earning the admiration, esteem and affection of his colleagues and the community-at-large; and

WHEREAS, With him throughout have been his wife, Michelle, and their three children, as well as two grandchildren, all of whom feel privileged to be a part of his life and rejoice in his achievements; and
