WHEREAS, Throughout his illustrious career, Officer Guy Danella has served as: a Field Training Officer, General Topics Instructor, Standardized Field Sobriety Instructor, Evidence Room Manager, Police Crime Field and Evidence Specialist, Evidence Technician, and Passenger Safety Technician; and

WHEREAS, Officer Guy Danella has been the recipient of numerous awards and accolades, including: the Meritorious Award, Exceptional Service Award, Life Saving Award, 10-year Service Award, Educational Achievement Award, The Patriot Award, two DWI Department Awards from Oneida County Sheriff's Department, and seven DWI Department Awards from the New York Mills Village Police Department; and
