establishing a plan setting forth an itemized list of grantees for certain appropriations for the 2021-2022 state fiscal year for additional grants-in-aid to certain school districts, public libraries, and not-for-profit institutions

RESOLVED, In addition to grants allocated pursuant to section 1 of chapter 53 of the laws of 2021, within the State Education Department Aid to Localities:

Additional funds appropriated in state fiscal year 2021-2022 pursuant to section 1 of chapter 53 of the laws of 2021 which enacts the aid to localities budget to the state education department under the prekindergarten through grade twelve education program from the general fund, local assistance account for additional grants-in-aid to certain school districts, public libraries, and not-for-profit institutions.
