WHEREAS, Miranda Rand has been called upon to contribute her time and talents to countless civic and charitable endeavors and has always given of herself unstintingly; she is the President of the Interfaith Community of Schenectady, a Board Member for the Working Group on Girls of Schenectady, Inc., and has been involved in several ecumenical and/or interfaith programs and projects; and
