

Senate, Assembly Republicans holding roundtable today in Corning to discuss gas tax hike proposed by Legislature's Democrat leaders

ISSUE: GAS TAXES



The proposal being advanced by the Democrat majorities in the Senate and Assembly could increase the cost of gasoline by as much as 55 cents per gallon and raise home heating costs by more than 25 percent.

State Senator Tom O'Mara (R,C,I-Big Flats) and Assemblyman Phil Palmesano (R,C,I-Corning) will join legislative colleagues to host a roundtable discussion with industry stakeholders regarding the Climate and Community Investment Act (CCIA, S.4264/A.6967).

The CCIA, a proposal being advanced by the Democrat majorities in the Senate and Assembly, could increase the cost of gasoline by as much as 55 cents per gallon and raise home heating costs by more than 25 percent.
