| ISSUE: **GOVERNOR HOCHUL**, **COVID-19 TREATMENTS**



We are not even a full week into the new year and Democrat leaders are already despicably playing identity politics with the pandemic. It is unacceptable that an official New York State COVID memorandum contains language suggesting that the color of one's skin will be a factor in whether he or she has access to COVID treatment. There should only be one basis for treatment; and that is medical need.
