MEMORIALIZING Governor Kathy Hochul to proclaim  
February 8, 2022, as Safer Internet Day in the State  
of New York

New York; and

WHEREAS, Attendant to such concern, and fully in accord with its  
long- standing traditions, it is the sense of this Legislative Body to  
memorialize Governor Kathy Hochul to proclaim February 8, 2022, as Safer  
Internet Day; and

WHEREAS, On Tuesday, February 8, 2022, the 19th edition of Safer  
Internet Day will celebrate with actions taking place across the globe;  
and

WHEREAS, This year's theme, "The internet starts with I & ends with  
T," asks the public to think about what they can do to make the internet  
better and safer; and

WHEREAS, Whether you are a young person, a parent or caregiver, a  
teacher or an educator, a policy maker, or whether you represent an  
organization or industry, everyone has a role to play in creating and

maintaining a better online world; and

WHEREAS, Noting the global reach of the Safer Internet Day campaign, global Safer Internet Day Committees and a range of organizational and industry supporters have spent tireless hours planning and discussing the activities of this vital day; and

WHEREAS, It is imperative that there be greater public awareness of this serious issue, and more must be done to increase activity at the local, State and National levels; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Legislative Body pause in its deliberations to memorialize Governor Kathy Hochul to proclaim February 8, 2022, as Safer Internet Day in the State of New York; and be it further
