WHEREAS, After her husband passed away in 2007, Agnes E. Woodrow lived alone for 10 years before moving in with her daughter Karen Pike and her husband Francis in their home in Russell, New York; and

WHEREAS, With her zest for life, this exceptional centenarian has inspired and enhanced the lives of her family and friends; she has truly enriched those around her through her joyous and sincere love for others and through the quiescent charm and wisdom which comes only from a fullness of years; and
