WHEREAS, Armed with a humanistic spirit and imbued with a sense of compassion, Abraham Schumer leaves behind a legacy which will long endure the passage of time and will remain as a comforting memory to all he served and befriended; he will be deeply missed and truly merits the grateful tribute of this Legislative Body; now, therefore, be it
