WHEREAS, On October 30, 2021, Paul Longo recorded his 212th career win, becoming Suffolk County's all-time winningest football coach with a decisive 37-15 victory over Ward Melville High School; during the remainder of the season, he and his team went on to win two more games; and

WHEREAS, Throughout his tenure, Coach Paul Longo has led the Colonials to 13 county titles, and between 2005-2008, he and his student athletes enjoyed a 42-game winning streak, a Long Island football record; in 2007, Sports Illustrated magazine ranked his squad as one of the 25 best teams in the country; and

WHEREAS, In addition to his role of Coach, Paul Longo was a guidance counselor at William Paca Middle School for 33 years, which provided valuable skills for his success as a coach and mentor; he truly loves his athletes, and has always enjoyed getting to know each and every one of them; and

WHEREAS, Coach Paul Longo has clearly made a contribution to the spirit of excellence which is a tradition of his Suffolk community; and

WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body that when individuals of such outstanding athletic accomplishments are brought to

our attention, they should be recognized by all the citizens of this great Empire State; now, therefore, be it
