MEMORIALIZING Governor Kathy Hochul to proclaim  
February 11, 2022, as P.S. I Love You Day in the  
State of New York

WHEREAS, It is the custom of this Legislative Body to recognize  
official days that are set aside to increase awareness of serious mental  
health issues that affect the lives of citizens of New York State; and

WHEREAS, Attendant to such concern, and in full accord with its  
long-standing traditions, this Legislative Body is justly proud to  
memorialize Governor Kathy Hochul to proclaim February 11, 2022, as P.S.  
I Love You Day in the State of New York; and

WHEREAS, P.S. I Love You Day, this year celebrating its 12th  
Anniversary, is held annually on the second Friday of February in over  
100 communities across New York State; and

WHEREAS, P.S. I Love You Day was initiated in 2010 by founders  
Jaimie and Brooke DiPalma, along with their family and the West Islip  
High School Class of 2014, to celebrate the memory of their father and  
anyone in the State of New York who has been lost to suicide; they used  
the last three words their father said to them, "I Love You", as the  
inspiration for this significant day; and

WHEREAS, An active member of his community, Joseph DiPalma, Jr. was

a former NYPD officer, ex-Chief of the West Islip Fire Department, and President of his Local Chamber of Commerce; tragically, he passed away on April 23, 2010; and

WHEREAS, P.S. I Love You Day invites all New Yorkers to wear purple on February 11, 2022, in an effort to bring awareness to the importance of mental health, to stand up to bullying, and to spread kindness; and

WHEREAS, It is imperative that there be greater awareness of serious mental health conditions, and more must be done to increase activity at the local, State and National levels; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Legislative Body pause in its deliberations to memorialize Governor Kathy Hochul to proclaim February 11, 2022, as P.S. I Love You Day in the State of New York; and be it further
