
Dear Neighbor,

Every year, Senator Kevin Thomas honors a select few local businesses and organizations that demonstrate unique vision, innovation, volunteerism, philanthropy, and achievement in support of our community. Over the years, the scope of the New York State Empire 'Excellence in Business' Award has grown to acknowledge businesses and organizations that have directly contributed to New York State's economic resilience and success. Senator Kevin Thomas is seeking nominees for the 2022 New York State 'Excellence in Business' Empire Award. The Senator will consider local businesses who meet *any* of the following criteria:

- A Business or Institution That Gives Back: A business whose acts of volunteerism, leadership, philanthropy, and innovation elevate our community and make it a better place for everyone to do business, work, and live.
- A Family-Owned Small Business: Nominees must serve as a majority owner & operator or bear principal responsibility for operating a small business with at least a 15-year track record that has been passed down through one or more generations.
- A Veteran-Owned Small Business: A business that is at least 51% veteran-owned with a successful track record and a commitment to strengthen veteran-owned businesses within the community.
- A Woman or Minority-Owned Small Business: A business that is at least 51% women-owned with a successful track record and a commitment to strengthen woman-owned businesses within the community or any individual who qualifies as a minority and who owns at least 51% and operates a small business with a 3-year track record and a commitment to strengthen minority-owned businesses in the community.
